

A Parents' Guide to Google Classrooms



What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom as your child's digital link to learning.

We use Google Classroom to share homework, newsletters and much more with you and your child.

Getting started!

Your child was provided with a secure login and password (please see reading records) that is unique to them.

1.



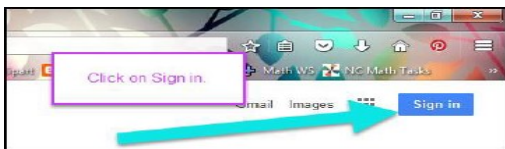
Click on The Google Chrome browser icon.

2. Type https://

classroom.google.com/ into the web address bar.



3. Click on SIGN IN in the upper right hand corner of the browser window.



4. Type in your child's Google Email address & click 'next'.

5. Type in your child's password & click 'next'. Click save to avoid typing your child's login details each time.

NB:- If this is the first time you have logged in, the system may ask you to 'continue' and then select "I am a student".

You should now see your class on the screen and you can click "join".

To use the Google classroom!

6. There will be two main pages in the google classroom that your child will need to access. These are the "stream" and the "classwork". The 'people' page just lists the children and staff in your google classroom.



The "stream" is where the teacher will post announcements. Your child can also post comments or questions on the stream by typing in the box which says "Share something with your class". Please be aware everyone in the class can see everything that is written on the stream.

The "classwork" is where the work will be posted each day.

Contacting your child's teacher

Your child can post a comment or question to their teacher onto the "stream". Please be aware everyone in the class can see everything that is written on the stream.

Your child's teacher, and sometimes the class teaching assistants, will be monitoring the google classroom.
