Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to notify you of the programme of enrichment clubs for Summer term 2026. Enrichment clubs are an important part of school life and something we are very passionate about, so much so that teachers give up their lunch break to run a weekly club. Please also note there is a new price for ComputerXplorers afterschool club.

The programme is a mix of clubs provided by outside organisers and school staff, there are also clubs run within school by invite only so your child may be asked to attend an extra club that isn't listed. Children are invited to make choices about the **TWO** clubs which take place within the school day and then put them in preference order to allow us to try and distribute places as fairly as we are able to.

Where there are costs involved these clubs require applications to be made directly to the organisers or school office so please read the overview carefully. Please could we request that school club places are paid for no later than **Friday 3rd April** in order to secure your child's place, clubs that have not been pre-paid will be reallocated to children on the waiting list.

Application forms need to be returned to school by **Monday 16th March 2026** to allow time for the sorting process. Confirmation of places allocated will be sent home by **Friday 27th March**, so that clubs can start in full during the week beginning **Monday 13th April 2026**, please see external clubs information for start and finish dates. They will then run for 13 weeks with the final week being the week beginning of **Monday 13th July 2026**. We are proud to be able to work to support parents by running our clubs right from the beginning of term to the very end of term.

Once a child has been accepted into a place for a club the expectation is that they will attend each week (unless off school or for a reason given in writing by the parent) as there may have been other children who were unsuccessful in getting a place. This applies whether the club is at lunchtime or after school. Equally as clubs are being offered as an additional opportunity, school staff or outside providers have the right to withdraw a child from their club if their behaviour or attitude does not reflect our school values.

We are looking forward to once again providing the children of Holtspur School with the opportunity to extend their participation in school life into a wider variety of activities and pursuits.
